Arnold Palmer's wonderfully designed golf course, The Bog, has 18 holes surrounded by beautiful rolling hills and natural wooded areas. Ozaukee County Pioneer Village is a living history museum that allows visitors to experience a rural village of the past with over 20 unique buildings nestled in a rolling hillside.
