Summer is great for al fresco dining in Ozaukee County

A favorite for many is outside dining – whether you’re looking for a date night, a quick bite to eat with the family, gathering with friends or watching entertainment, Ozaukee County has many eateries that embrace our wonderful summer weather by offering casual dining on outdoor patios and balconies.

You’ll forget you’re in Wisconsin when you dine along the shores of Lake Michigan in Port Washington. Dockside Deli offers breakfast and lunch with marina and lake views – enjoy sandwiches, wraps, delicious freshly baked desserts and ice cream. Head a little further north and check out Newport Shores. Throughout the summer, its outdoor patio offers daily dining and

weekly live music. The Rusty Anchor Saloon & Eatery at the Holiday Inn Harborview in Port Washington offers a casual, nautical theme with a patio that overlooks the water. Down the road among the historic buildings and shopping, Beanies Mexican Restaurant offers authentic Mexican food with indoor and outdoor seating. The Chocolate Chisel across the street provides an outdoor area to sit and enjoy homemade ice cream, chocolates and coffees. Inventors Brewpub offers a beautiful view of Veterans Memorial Park and Lake Michigan, perfect for enjoying a craft beer, soda and the traditional Canadian dish poutine among other delicious offerings. Heading south, stop in Saukville and enjoy a delicious homemade pizza or sandwich among other wonderful dishes at Riverview Inn TNG. There’s a wait? Relax in the outdoor waiting area.

Cedarburg has a number of places to enjoy socializing with friends over dinner, a cold beverage and ice cream in the open air. At 5 Corners in the town of Cedarburg, you will find Wayne’s Drive-In (celebrating 20 years in business). This 1950s-style diner offers American favorites from burgers to grilled cheese, sundaes and malts made with Cedar Crest Ice Cream ... and don’t forget Thursday Classic Cruise Nights. Down the road a short distance on Highway 60, The Fermentorium Brewery offers outdoor seating that’s great for enjoying a cold craft brew with a snack, pizza or the hot dog of the month.

In the city of Cedarburg, take in the beauty of Cedar Creek on the Vintage Café & City

Deli's back patio, where you can enjoy a delicious sandwich, salad and a glass of Cedar Creek wine. The

Stilt House's outdoor patio is open along the Ozaukee Interurban Trail. Enjoy delicious small plate dining and an extensive menu of high-end American craft beers along Cedar Creek. Head south down Washington Avenue to Out & Out for sandwiches, wraps, custard and more at the nice wide-open outdoor patio.

To the east in Grafton, Atlas BBQ offers a large patio and streetside dining for enjoying tasty BBQ dishes and extensive list of beverages. There are a few places in Grafton for enjoying pizza outdoors, including the local favorite John's Pizzeria, where you can also choose salads and other menu items ... and even Little Caesars offers outdoor dining for families on the go. East of Interstate 43, you will find Juice's Ghost Town, which offers daily specials and an outdoor deck for dining.

In southern Ozaukee County, the cheel in Thiensville offers unique American and Nepalese small plates, meals and craft cocktails – you’ll love the 1890s building, art deco bar and beautiful outdoor patio suffused with a contemporary Asian feel. Mequon's Libby Montana Bar & Grill offers casual outdoor dining along the Interurban Trail – a great family-friendly place to enjoy burgers, steaks, ribs and more. On a beautiful summer day, Café Hollander's unique open-air design makes the whole restaurant feel like an outdoor European-inspired grand café. The extensive outdoor patios and balconies double the restaurant's capacity and offer a combination of city and Milwaukee River views.

There are a number of other wonderful partner restaurants that offer a comfortable and welcoming atmosphere as you move through Ozaukee County, such as New Fortune Asian

Cuisine in Cedarburg; Rivers Edge Restaurant in Saukville, a local favorite for breakfast and lunch; Ferrante's in Mequon for pizza, lasagna, fish fries and more; and the Seven Hills Pub & Grille, located inside the Country Inn & Suites in Port Washington.
